Gives £10 to <u>his kinsman Noah Tayler of Heathfield</u> in the county of Sussex, shoemaker.

Gives £10 to his kinsman Raynald Tayler one of the sons of his brother Robert.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Mary Knight one of the daughters of his brother Robert</u> Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Elizabeth Bryant another daughter of his brother Robert</u> Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Margaret Tyherst one of the daughters of his brother</u> Richard Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Katherin Woode another daughter of his brother Richard Tayler.</u>

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Mary Keyne late the wife of</u> [blank] <u>Keyne</u> and <u>another</u> daughter of his brother Richard Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Mary Reede one of the daughters of his brother John</u> Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Suzan Tayler one of the daughters of his brother James</u> Tayler.

Gives £5 to <u>his kinswoman Margery Prior another of the daughters of his brother</u> James Tayler.

Gives 40 shillings to <u>his kinsman Richard Taylor son of Nicholas Taylor</u> [written in the left margin].

Gives 40 shillings to Andrew Tayler son of Nicholas Tayler.

Gives 40 shillings to Joane Laddams wife of James Laddams.

Gives 40 shillings to Nicholas Pococke of Mayfield.

Gives 40 shillings to Richard Pococke of Mayfield.

Gives 40 shillings to Isaac Reede of Ticehurst.

Gives 40 shillings to Nicholas Reede of Fante [Frant].

Gives £6 to his servant Alice Pococke.

Appoints <u>his kinsman John Tayler of Heathfield youngest son of his brother James Tayler deceased</u> sole executor of his last will and testament, and to whom he gives all the residue of his goods, chattels &c. Thomas also gives and bequeaths to John his freehold and copyhold messuages, lands and tenements in the parish of Battle, as well as those lands and tenements he purchased from George Bourner of Battle. Additionally he gives and bequeaths to the said John his lands and tenements in Bexhill in the county of Sussex.

Nominates his friend George Cole of Battle as overseer and supervisor of his last will and testament, and gives him 40 shillings for his efforts.

Gives and bequeaths to <u>his kinsman Thomas Tayler of Heathfield</u>, yeoman, <u>one of the sons of his brother John Tayler</u>, all his lands, messuages, tenements and woods within the parish of Heathfield in the county of Sussex which he purchased of Nicholas Panckherst of Heathfield.
