Abstract of the Will of Robert Bathe of Wotton Bassett in the County of Wiltes, Yeoman, written 27 Aug 1672, inventory taken 2 Sep 1672, will proved 5 May 1673. [4](#)

Gives & bequeaths to **his son Richard Bathe** his house and back garden, and after Richard's death to **Patient Bathe, Richard's wife**, and to their heirs forever. And for lack for such heirs he gives & bequeaths the same to his son Thomas Bathe and his heirs.

Gives & bequeaths to **his daughter Mary Webb** one coffer standing in the chamber.

Gives & bequeaths to **Thomas Newth the son of his daughter Jone Newth** his biggest kettle.

Gives & bequeaths to his said son Richard Bathe his tableboard, cupboard & benches.

Gives & bequeaths to **his son-in-law William Webb** one joyne chaire standing in the chamber and one pair of

Gives & bequeaths to **Anne Parker the daughter of his daughter Susan Parker** one petticoat and one pewter platter.

Gives & bequeaths to **Mary Newth daughter of his said daughter Joane Newth** one petticoat and one ----coat.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives & bequeaths to **his son Thomas Bathe** whom he makes the sole executor of his last will and testament.

Nominates **his brother John Bathe** and Richard Clarke to be overseers of his last will and testament.
