Gives £25 to his daughter Anne Brinsden.

Gives £25 to his daughter Alice Brinsden.

All the rest of his goods & chattels he gives to **his wife Mary** and makes her the sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Desires that his friends Robert Bathe and John Boxall be overseers of his last will and testament.
