Abstract of the Nuncupative Will of Michael Chesterman of Cleeve Pepper in the County of Wilts, yeoman, dictated on 4 Jan 1690/1.

Gives all his goods and chattels to his wife to be disposed of as she thinks fit, except what had come to him from his wife's brother, namely the table and everything in the chamber over the hall, left as a standard to the house and never to be moved, because this is what his brother-in-law desired.
