Abstract of the Will of Thomas Chesterman of Tytherton Kellaways in the Parish of Bremhill in the County of Wilts, Yeoman, written 13 Feb 1830, proved 2 Dec 1836.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to his nephew William Chesterman* when he turns 14.

The residue and remainder of his property he gives and bequeaths to **his wife Patience Chesterman** for her natural life unless she re-marries. If she does remarry, then he gives and bequeaths the same equally between his wife Patience
Chesterman, **his daughter Mary Chesterman** and **his daughter Ann Chesterman**.

Appoints his said wife Patience Chesterman sole executor of his last will and testament.
