

Probate records of the Archdeaconry of Wiltshire, Reference: P1/E/53.

Abstract of the Will of Ellen Elliott of the Parish of Compton Chamberlayne in the County of Wilts, Widow, written 14 Mar 1635, proved 18 Apr 1635.

Wills that her body be buried in the churchyard of Compton Chamberlayne.

Gives 12 pence to her parish church of Compton.

Gives 5 shillings to the poor of the said parish.

Gives 12 pence each to **her daughters Margery Hibbard, Elinor Hibbard and Edyth Joye**.

Gives 20 shillings to **her grandchild Richard Wheeler**, to be paid to him when he reaches the age of twenty years.

The rest of her goods, tenements and chattels she gives to **her son James Elliott** whom she makes sole executor of her last will and testament.

Nominates **her brother-in-law Robert Comage** and her friend Richard Case overseers of her last will and testament.
