*Abstract of the Will of Hester Hawkins of Oatsey in the County of Wilts, Widow,  
written 5 Feb 1835, proved 16 Apr 1841.*

Gives all of her personal estate, lands, tenements and hereditaments to her trustees  
and friends John Yorke, gentleman, Thomas Warman, grocer, and Charles Pearce . .  
. . . . . , draper, all of Wootton Bassett, for the benefit of **her three grandchildren:**  
**Hester Maskelyne Hopkin, Lucy Ann Hopkin, and Edward Hopkin**, in equal  
shares.

Appoints her trustees co-executors of her last will and testament.
