

Prerogative Court of Canterbury and related Probate Jurisdictions: Will Registers,
PROB 11/259/419

Abstract of the Will of John Hollister 'the Elder' of Wootton Bassett in the County of Wilts, Joiner, written 13 May 1656, proved 24 Nov 1656.

Gives & bequeaths £20 to **his daughter Joane Hollister**, along with his best bedstead and bed.

Gives & bequeaths to **his current wife Alice** the house and garden where he now lives, together with the barns, outhouses, and arable land in Coxstalls, for the term of her natural life. After she passes he gives and bequeaths the same to **his son William Hollister** and his heirs.

Gives 1 shilling to **his son John Hollister** and 12 pence to each of his children.

All the rest of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his wife Alice** whom he makes sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Appoints **his son William Hollister** overseer of his last will and testament.
