Gives 12 pence to his son Frauncis Jaye.

Gives 12 pence to his daughter Marye Combe.

Gives 12 pence to his daughter Alice Nycholas.

Gives 12 pence to his daughter Sara Trowbridge.

Gives £100 to his daughter Jane Jaye.

Gives 12 pence to **his son James Jaye**. Also gives to James and his heirs his land and tenement called Burcombe. And should James have no heirs, then he wills the same to his said daughter Jane and her heirs.

The residue of his goods and chattels he gives and bequeaths to **Mary his wife** whom he makes sole executrix of his last will and testament.

Makes John Puxton, gent., **Frauncys Jaye** and **Thomas Jaye** of East Hatch overseers of his last will and testament.
