Abstract of the Will of Anstase (Anstes) Jeffery (Gefferey) of Ebbesborne Wake, widow, written 22 Mar 1549, proved 3 Oct 1549.

Directs that her body be buried in the churchyard of Ebbesborne Wake.

Gives and bequeaths to **her son Bartholomew** one plough with a "cultur & share", one yoke, one iron coop?, an iron bond for a cart, one harrow, one pot, and one pan.

Gives and bequeaths to **her daughter Elizabeth** one pot, a pan, an acre of wheat and one of barley.

Gives to Alice Nepered one ewe sheep.

Gives to Jone Jeffery her son's daughter* one lamb.

Gives to Richard Ingram two bushells of barley.

Gives to Thomas Nepered two bushells of barley.

All the residue of her goods she gives to **her son Harry** whom she makes sole executor of her last will and testament.
