

Wiltshire, England, Wills and Probate, 1530-1858, Reference: P2/2Reg/88A.

*Abstract of the Will of Anstase (Anstes) Jeffery (Gefferey) of Ebbesborne Wake, widow, written 22 Mar 1549, proved 3 Oct 1549.*

Directs that her body be buried in the churchyard of Ebbesborne Wake.

Gives and bequeaths to **her son Bartholomew** one plough with a "cultur & share", one yoke, one iron coop?, an iron bond for a cart, one harrow, one pot, and one pan.

Gives and bequeaths to **her daughter Elizabeth** one pot, a pan, an acre of wheat and one of barley.

Gives to Alice Nepered one ewe sheep.

Gives to **Jone Jeffery her son's daughter\*** one lamb.

\* Jone was the eldest child of Henry ("Harry") Jeffery.

Gives to Richard Ingram two bushells of barley.

Gives to Thomas Nepered two bushells of barley.

All the residue of her goods she gives to **her son Harry** whom she makes sole executor of her last will and testament.
