Gives 12 pence to her daughter Alice Nicholas.

Gives 12 pence to her daughter Jane Dowding.

All the residue of her personal goods she gives and bequeaths to **her son James Joye** whom she makes sole executor of her last will and testament.

Appoints **her son Francis Joye** and Richard Case to be overseers of her last will and testament.
