Makes the said **John Parham** a residuary legatee with the intent that John pays **his mother Mary Maskelyne*** an annuity of £15. Directs that, following the death of his mother, he bequeaths the residue of the legacy to **his son Neville Maskelyne**.

Appoints the said **John Parham** and William Dyer of Eascott as guardians of his son.
