Gives, devises & bequeaths to **his mother, Martha Maskelyne**, all the freehold messuage or tenement with garden ground and premises bequeathed to him in his late father's Will. And after her death he bequeaths the same to **his brother Thomas Maskelyne** and his heirs.

Gives & bequeaths to **his brother William Maskelyne** and **his sister Anne Mundee** the interest accrued on the legacy bequeathed to him by his late father, to be equally divided between them.

Gives & bequeaths £20 out of his personal estate to his brother Giles Maskelyne.

Nominates and appoints his said mother, Martha Maskelyne, sole executrix of his last will and testament.
