*Abstract of the Will of Joanna Short of Wootton Bassett in the County of Wilts,
written 29 Oct 1710, proved 26 Apr 1715.*

Gives & bequeaths to **her cousin Charles Hollister and his wife Grace** 20 shillings
each to by funeral rings.

Gives to **her cousin Ann Rumboll** her best suit of linen and her silk petticoat.

Gives & bequeaths her wedding ring to **her granddaughter Joanna Short**.

Gives & bequeaths another ring to **her granddaughter Christian Short**.

Gives & bequeaths to **her granddaughter Elizabeth Short** another of her gold
rings.

All the rest of her house, lands, goods, chattels and ready money she gives and
bequeaths to **her son William Short** whom she makes sole executor of her last will
and testament.
