Gives & bequeaths 2 guineas to **Rebeckah Short** of Malmsbury, widow.*

Gives & bequeaths 1 guinea to Allice Kendall alias Meedham.†

Gives & bequeaths 1 guinea to **Anne Short**, spinster, **sister of the said Allice Kendall alias Meedham**.

Gives & bequeaths to his kinsman and servant Thomas Short[‡] son of John Short his best suit of clothes.

Gives & bequeaths to the said Josiah Hicks his second-best suit of clothes.

Gives & bequeaths to Richard Weaving of Wootton Bassett his great coat and a buckskin pair of breeches.

All the rest of his ready money, bills, bonds, debts due and owing, cattle stock, plate, goods, chattels and personal estate he gives and bequeaths to **his wife Eleanor Short**, whom he appoints sole executrix of his last will and testament.
