- Item: gives and bequeaths to **his son John** one plough and all things thereto belonging. He also gives and bequeaths to his son John twenty sheep.
- Item: gives and bequeaths to his son Richard xx sheep.
- Item: gives and bequeaths to his son Nicholas twenty sheep
- Item: gives and bequeaths to his son Robert twenty sheep
- Item: gives and bequeaths to his son Thomas twenty sheep
- Item: gives and bequeathss to his son Andrew twenty sheep
- Item: gives and bequeaths to every one of his sons an acre of barley
- Item: gives and bequeaths to his daughter Margerie ten pounds
- The residue of his goods unbequeathed and not given he bequeaths and gives to **his wife Joanne** whom he ordains and makes his sole Executrix
- ordains and makes as supervisors and overseers of his last will and testament **Richard Webbe*** and John Baylie.
