Gives and bequeaths his farming stock, implements of husbandry, household goods, money in the house and securities for money to **his daughter Catherine** who is currently living with him.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate and effects he gives and bequeaths to his said daughter Catherine whom he nominates and appoints sole Executrix of his last will and testament.
