Gives & bequeaths £10 to her son James Vincent, Clerk, and two silver tumblers.

Gives & bequeaths 20 shillings to the poor of the parish of Llanfachraeth.

Gives & bequeaths to Owen Owens of Llanfigail, Weaver, half a pegget of Barley, a measure of rye and a measure of pilcorn.

Gives & bequeaths the rest & residue of her goods, chattels & credits to **her daughters Catherine, Anne & Jane Vincent**, whom she constitutes, nominates and appoints joint executrices of her last will and testament.

Also appoints Robert Bulkeley of Granant, Esq<sup>r</sup>. & Henry Thomas of Tre-dolphin?, Yeoman, to be trustees and overseers of her last will and testament.
