*Abstract of the Will of Anne Edwards of Nanhoron in Botwnnog in the County of Caernarvon, Widow of the late Richard Edwards Esq<sup>r</sup>., deceased, written 20 Nov 1705, proved 8 Jan 1705/6.*

Refers to an Indenture between her late husband and herself for the selling of both their real estate wherein a power is reserved to her in case she outlives him to dispose of the lands named in the Indenture for two years ensuing her decease. By the power invested in her by the said Indenture she gives, devises & bequeaths the said term of two years in the said premises to **her son Timothy Edwards** and his heirs, out of the issues, rents & profits of which he shall pay £5 **her son Jeremiah Edwards**, £10 to **her son John Edwards**, and £5 to **her grandchild Anne Nanney**, £5 to **her grandchild Anne Griffith**, £5 to **her grandchild Anne Holland**, £5 to **her grandchild Anne Lloyd**, and £5 to **her grandchild Anne Edwards**.

All the rest and residue of her estate she gives and bequeaths to her said son Timothy Edwards whom she constitutes and appoints sole executor of her last will and testament.
