Abstract of the Will of Richard Glynne of Elernion in the Parish of Llanaelhaearn in the County of Caernarfon, Esq., written 17 May 1702, proved 31 Jan 1732.

Gives and bequeaths to **his wife Anne** a yearly rent charge of £60 for and during her natural life, issuing out of all his messuages, mills, lands, tenements & hereditaments.

Gives, devises & bequeaths all his capital messuage called Elernion and all other his messuages, mills, lands, tenements, rents & hereditaments and their appurtenances in the County of Carnarvon to James Brinkir of Brinkir, Esq. and William Owen of Drenlyn in county Anglesey, in Trust, subject to the payment of the said yearly rent charge to his wife abovementioned, and subject to the payment of several other legacies shown below, and to the use of **his sister Ellin Glynne, spinster**, for and during the term of her natural life and, after her decease, to the eldest son lawfully born of her, and so on.

And in default of issue of his sister Ellin Glynne, then to the use of **his aunt Anne Jones of Clenenney** in county Carnarvon, widow and to the heirs of her body lawfully begotten.

And in default of such issue, to the use of **his cousin Ellin Glynne of Glynlirion** in county Carnarvon, spinster, for and during the term of her natural life. And after her decease to the eldest son lawfully born of her, and so on.

And in default of such issue, to the use of **his cousin Catherine Goodman, daughter of his aunt Elizabeth Goodman**.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to the poor of the parish of Llanaylhayarn in county Carnarvon.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to the poor of the parish of Clynog in county Carnarvon.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to the poor of the parish of Llanllyfin.

Gives and bequeaths £1 the poor of Penmorva.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his aunt Jane Evans a/s. Glynne**.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his cousin Elis Evans**.

Gives and bequeaths 40 shillings to **his cousins Jane Evans** and Elis ---?--- each.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to his cousin ---?---.

Gives and bequeaths £25 to his cousin ---?---.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to Margaret Owen late of Revenysgwyd.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to **his cousin Catherine Meyricke** of Muttley? Widow.

Gives and bequeaths to Love Parry of Kefn Llanvair Esq. all the interest he will owe him at the time of his decease.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to the said James Brynkir of Brynkir.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to **his godson James Brynkir**, youngest son of the said James Brynkir of Brynkir, to be paid to him when he reaches the age of twenty-one years.

Gives and bequeaths £---?--- to **his aunt Marry Glynne**.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his cousin Rodricke Lloyd** late of Plas-dû, Clerk.

Gives and bequeaths £20 to William Owen of Cremlyn.

Ordains and appoints **his mother Elizabeth Glynne** and his said sister Ellen Glynne executrices of his last will and testament.
