After the decease of his wife, he gives & devises the said Cefn Chwilog to his grandson William Jones, son of John Jones, Gentleman, and Margaret his wife.

All the rest of his personal estate, goods & chattels at **Tyn y Coed** aforesaid and **Fridd Bryncoch in the Parish of Llanddwywe in the County of Merioneth** he gives and devises to his wife Dorothy Jones, constituting and appointing her sole Executrix of his last will and testament.
