Item. Gives & bequeaths 5 shillings to her daughter Catherine the wife of John Williams, Gent.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 5 shillings to her daughter Anne the wife of Evan Prichard.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to **her eldest son Richard Lloyd** all the bedsteads, bedding and furniture in his bedchamber, along with the . . . . . . and all the tables and chairs in the chamber within the capital messuage on mansion house of Hafodwryd called the Hall.

Desires that **her daughter Barbara Lloyd** have the custody of her son Richard Lloyd . . . . [document fragmented from here on]

Appoints her d[aughter Bar]bara Lloyd Executrix of her last will and testament to whom she gives & bequeaths [the rest & res]idue of all her goods, cattle, chattels, rights, credits & person Est[ate]

Nominates, constitutes & desires that her . . . . . Lewis Owen of Peniarth in the county of Merioneth, Esq., her brother James Brynkir Esq., her brother[in-law] Roderick Lloyd Esq., and her cousin William Brynkir Esq. trustees & overseers of her last will and testament.
