Gives & bequeaths £30 to his niece Elizabeth Meyricke only daughter of his brother Captain Meyricke

Gives & bequeaths £5 to his Edmund Meyricke.

Gives & bequeaths £5 to his nephew Edmond Meyricke of Ucheldre in the county of Merioneth, Esq^r.

Gives & bequeaths £10 to his brother Oliver Thomas.

Gives & bequeaths £5 to his brother[in-law] James Brynker.

Makes & ordains his wife Catherine Meyricke sole executrix and residuary legatee of his last will and testament.
