Also wishes that all his late mother's letters and anything else that belonged to her be delivered to him.

Gives & bequeaths £20 to Eliza Williams (sister of the said Robert Vaughan Wynn Williams).

Gives & bequeaths £20 to her godson Wynn Williams (son of the said Robert Vaughan Wynn Williams).

Gives & bequeaths £100 to her goddaughter Louisa Ellen (daughter of her brother William Price Poole).

Gives & bequeaths £100 to Owen Anthony Poole (son of the said William Price Poole).

Gives & bequeaths £20 to Henry Robert (son of the said William Price Poole).

Gives & bequeaths £20 to Llewelyn Panton son of the said William Price Poole.

Gives & bequeaths £100 to her goddaughter Elizabeth Anne (daughter of her nephew Richard Anthony Poole).

Gives & bequeaths £400 to her nephew Henry John Alexander Poole.

Gives & bequeaths £50 to her sister Margaret Elizabeth Poole.

Gives & bequeaths £20 to Anne Haslem (wife of John Haslem the elder of Carnarvon esquire) for her sole & separate use.

All the rest & residue of her goods, chattels, securities and personal estates she gives & bequeaths to **her sister Mary Poole**, whom she appoints sole executrix of her last will and testament.
