Abstract of The Will of Ann Norman of St. Andrews, Widow, written 4 Jul 1710, proved 22 Dec 1712.

- Bequeaths to **her daughter Rachel Arnold** one black mantle, one cotton petticoat and 10 shillings
- Bequeaths to **her three grandsons Thomas William and John Arnold sons of Rachel Arnold** two shillings each
- Bequeaths to **Anne daughter of Rachel Arnold** two shillings
- Bequeaths to **her daughters Margaret Llewelin and Rachel Arnold** one cow between them called Gentle and ten shillings each
- Bequeaths to **her step-daughter Katherine Grant** two shillings six pence
- Bequeaths to **her daughter Wenllian Lewis** two cows , six acres, and three quarts? of wheat, barley and oats, two feather beds, one [--?--] bed, three feather bolsters, two cushions, one holland sheet, one canvas sheet, four pair of blankets, two pillow cases, and all other appurtenances to the beds, three bedsteads, her pewter dishes, brass pans and all other household stuff
- Appoints her daughter Wenllian Lewis as sole executrix of her last will and testament
- Witnesses: Thomas Mathew\*, Richard John, Edward Hooper

\* This is probably the same Thomas Mathew named in the will of Thomas Norman of Wrinston in Wenvoe (1653) as his grandson.
