Abstract of The Will of Thomas Norman of Wrinston, Wenvoe, Gent., written 15 Aug 1653.

- Recommends his body to be buried in the parish Church of St. Andrews
- Gives five shillings toward the reparations of the Parish Church of St. Andrews
- Bequeaths to the poor of the parish of St. Andrews five shillings
- Bequeaths to the poor of the parish of Wenvoe two bushels of barley
- Gives to **his wife Mary** and **daughter Johane** a messuage with arable lands, meadows and pasture in Wrinston, with the yearly rents and other duties.
- Bequeaths to **his grandson Thomas Mathew the son of Johan his daughter by Edward Mathew gent deceased** all the messuages and lands etc in Wenvoe after the death of his wife.
- Bequeaths to his servant William Thomas ten shillings
- Bequeaths to his maidservant Johan John four shillings
- Bequeaths to his servant John Horbert? five shillings
- Bequeaths his household stuff, chattels & stock to his wife, daughter and grandson to be divided equally
- Bequeaths to his grandson Thomas Mathew all monies still owing to him
- Appoints his wife Mary to be sole executrix of his last will and testament
- Appoints his friend and kinsman John Lloyd of Hotldon? Gent and Thomas Norman of Aber Nant Gent, to be his overseers & guardians of his grandson Thomas Mathew
