Devises & bequeaths to **his daughter Jonet Anwill** her executors administrators and assigns £100 arising from the issues of the several messuages, tenements and lands aforesaid.

Devises & bequeaths to **his son Thomas Anwill** his executors administrators and assigns £80 arising from the issues of the several messuages, tenements and lands aforesaid.

Nominates, constitutes & appoints **his wife Margaret** as executrix of his last will and testament.
