Abstract of the Will of Jane Anwyl of Plâs Llandecwyn in the County of Merioneth, widow, written 9 Nov 1751, inventory taken 3 Apr 1756, will proved 6 Dec 1756.

Gives & bequeaths £5 to **her son Edward Anwyl**.

Gives & bequeaths £10 to **her son Lewis Anwyl**.

Gives & bequeaths £17 10s. to **her daughter Jane Griffith, widow**, and to **her grandson William Griffith**, which amount came to her on the death of **Jane's son Robert Anwyl**, being a legacy left to him by the last will & testament of his father.

Gives & bequeaths to her said daughter Jane Griffith her best grey horse.

Gives & bequeaths £5 to **her granddaughter Elizabeth Anwyl daughter of her son Owen Anwyl lately deceased**.

All the rest & residue of her personal estate she gives & bequeaths to **her son William Anwyl** and daughter Jane Griffith to be equally divided between them, share and share alike, whom she nominates and appoints co-executors of her last will and testament.
