*Abstract of the Will of Jonathan Anwyl of Llugwy in the County of Merioneth, Esquire,
written 1 Dec 1849, proved 10 Apr 1852.*

Gives & bequeaths £350 to **Elizabeth Anwyl of Aberdovy.**

Gives & bequeaths £500 to his servant Ann Evans.

Gives & bequeaths £200 to his servant John Griffith.

Gives & bequeaths his estates called Llugwy and Espirlas in the Parish of Pennal,
and his cottages in the town of Machynlleth, and all his real estate to the use of **Evan
Anwyl the Younger, eldest son of Evan Anwyl of Hendreseivion in the Parish of
Llanwrin in the county of Montgomery, farmer**, appointing him sole executor of
his last will and testament.
