Gives and bequeaths £10 to his grandson John Jones son of Cadwalader Jones by his daughter Jane.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to his grandson Robert Jones of Wern bach.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to his grandson Lewis Jones of Wern bach.

Gives and bequeaths £10 to his granddaughter Martha Lloyd of the same place.

Nominates and appoints David Jones of Bryn hir and Richard Evans of Goppa, both in the parish of Trawsfynydd, to be guardians of his said grandsons and granddaughter, to take care of their money and lay it out at interest until they attain the age of twenty-one years.

Gives and bequeaths to **his wife Catherine Edmunds** and **his son Robert Jones** all his farming stock, implements of husbandry and household furniture at Gwndwn, share and share alike.

Gives and bequeaths to his son Robert Jones of Gwndwn his farm called Wern bâch in the parish of Trawsfynydd, together with the lands and hereditaments belonging to it.

All the rest, residue and remainder of his goods and personal estate he gives and bequeaths to his said son Robert Jones whom he nominates, constitutes and appoints sole executor of his last will and testament.
