Abstract of the Will of Richard Evan of Pandu in the Parish of Trawsfynydd in the County of Merioneth, written 8 May 1785, proved 18 Jul 1785.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his eldest son Evan**.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his second son Richard**.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his eldest daughter Ann**.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his second daughter Elizabeth**.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his third daughter Margared**.

Gives and bequeaths £3 to **his fourth daughter Gwen**.

Gives and bequeaths £50 and all his household furniture to **his wife Elin Richard**.

All the rest, residue and remainder of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to **his two youngest sons Edmund and Robert** whom he constitutes and appoints joint executors and residuary legatees of his last will and testament.
