Refers to a Deed of Settlement wherein a power was reserved to him to charge all the capital messuage, lands and tenements called Islaw'r ffordd to the sum of £150.

Gives and bequeaths £50 to his daughter Mary Griffith.

Gives and bequeaths £ . . to his daughter Catherine Griffith.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to his sisters Jane, Elizabeth, Ann and Mary.

Gives and bequeaths £200 to his said daughter Gainor Griffith due to him on several . . . . as well as £40 due on note from . . . . Williams.

Gives and bequeaths £5 to **his wife Jane Prees**, to be paid out of the stock and effects at Gerddibluog that his said daughter Gainor shall be instituted to by law . . . .

Gives and bequeaths to his son and heir Griffith William all his personal . . . . . . .

Nominates and appoints his said daughter Gainor Griffith sole Executrix of his last will and testament.

Appoints his friend Robert . . . . of Barmouth to be Trustee and Overseer of his last will and testament.
