The Will of John ap John of Lanbedr, written 4 Feb 1716, proved 20 Nov 1720.

February the 4th, 1716.

I John ab John of the Parish of Llanbedr (aged about 100 years, yet of perfect memory, to God be prayse) Do make & declare this to be my last Will & Testament in the manner following (that is to say)

In the first place I Committ my Soul to the tender mercies of my God, thro' the merits of my charitable Saviour, and my body to be interr'd after [the] manner as my Executrix named hereunder shall think fitt.

In the next place I give & bequeath to my Son John Jones Six & twenty Pounds, To Thomas ab Edward I give fifteen pounds, I also give to William Thomas the son of the said Thomas ab Edward five pounds, To my Grandaughter Mary Jones, daughter of my eldest daughter Elizabeth I bequeath six pounds, To Grace Jones another daughter of the said Elizabeth I give four pounds, I bequeath here also to my said daughter Elizabeth Jones fourty shillings And to her son John Jones I give hereby fourty shillings also

Item. I give to **John Jones another grandson of mine** (**Son to my said Son John Jones**) All the Interest of this Money hereby bequeathed, that are already accrew'd, which shall accrew (untill they are paid, by the heiresses of Pla-- Coch & Llanelltyd....

I further Give & Bequeath to **Margaret Jones naturall daughter to John Jones my aforementioned Son** Ten pounds out of another Stock of money due to me from Mr. Robert Wynn of Ruthin provided She behave herself towards me & my Executrix & not otherwise.

I also hereby nominate & appoint my old Comfort & beloved wife Sole Executrix of this my last Will & Testament & To Whom I likewise leave all the rest and residue of my Estate reall & personall....
