Abstract of the Will of Robert Jones of Maes-yr-Elfor in the Parish of Llanfair-juxta-Harlech in the County of Merioneth, Farmer, written 7 Mar 1843, proved 18 Oct 1843.

Gives and bequeaths £5 each to his two sons and daughter of **his former wife Catherine**.

Gives and bequeaths to his several daughters of **his present wife Jennett** the following sums of money:

- £15 to **his daughter Lowry (the wife of Edward Owen)**
- £30 to **his daughter Anne (the wife of John Morgan otherwise Jones)**
- £15 to **his daughter Barbara (the wife of Robert Jones)**

Gives and bequeaths £140 to his wife Jennett, as well as his four-post bedstead, his feather bed, the clothing and curtains belonging to the same, and the large oak wainscot chest in the room above the parlour.

All the residue of his personal estate and effects he gives and bequeaths to **his daughter Sarah (the wife of William Jones)**, constituting, nominating and appointing the said William Jones sole Executor of his last will and testament.
