And in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty five....

The Condition of this Obligation is such; that if Edward Lloyd and Edmund Lloyd above-bounden Administrators of all and singular the Goods, Chattels, and Credits of Evan Lloyd of Cau-coch in the Parish of Trawsfynydd Gent — their late deceased father do make or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the Goods, Chattels and Credits of the said Deceased, which have or shall come to the Hands Possession or Knowledge of them the said Edward Lloyd and Edmund Lloyd and the same so made do exhibit or cause to be exhibited into the Registry of Bangor Court at or before the fourteenth Day of March next ensuing....
