Will of Evan Lloyd of Borthwen Terrace, Gent., written 17 May 1853, proved 29 Sep 1853.

This is the last Will and Testament of me Evan Lloyd of Borthwen Terrace Barmouth in the County of Merioneth Gentleman. I give devise and bequeath All and singular my real and personal Estate of what nature soever and wheresoever situate with their and every of their appurtenances unto **my dear Wife Catharine Lloyd** her Heirs Executors administrators or assigns according to the nature of each to and for her and their own use and benefit and her appoint her Executrix of this my Will. In Witness whereof I have hereto set my hand and seal this seventeenth day of May one thousand eight hundred and fifty three 1853.

Signed sealed published acknowledged and declared by the Testator as and for his Will in the presence of us who in his presence at his request and in the presence of each other have hereunto put our Names as Witnesses.
