*Abstract of the Will of John Lloyd of Blaen y ddôl in the Parish of Corwen in the County of Merioneth, Clerk, written 18 Feb 1725/6, proved 28 May 1731.*

Gives and bequeaths all his books to such of **his daughter Magdalen Roberts's** children as Griffith Roberts her husband shall think desirable.

Whereas **his son-in-law Griffith Roberts** owes him by bond £200 of which he has repaid £10, he wills that his said son-in-law pay to John Lloyd's brothers and sisters the yearly sum of £3 10s.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to his said son-in-law Griffith Roberts, nominating, constituting and appointing him sole Executor of his last will and testament.
