Imprimis. Gives & bequeaths to **her grandson Robert Griffith** all her plate at Plas Tan y Bwlch and all the furniture in his own and servant's rooms, in the Hall and Hall Chamber.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to her grandson William Anwil of Hendre mûr 2 guineas...

Item. Gives & bequeaths £100 to **her grandson Meyrick Anwyl**, the interest of which to be paid to him yearly until he receives the £100.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £40 to her grandson Thomas Anwyl.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £50 to her granddaughter Anne Anwyl.

Item. Gives & bequeaths all her household stuff and furniture at Berthlwyd (except her silver spoons) to her granddaughters **Anne**, **Jane & Jonett Anwyl**....

Item. Gives & bequeaths to her son-in-law Humphrey Meredith of Havod lwyfog 10 quineas to buy himself a silver plate.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to Elizabeth Morgan of Plas Tan y Bwlch 1 guinea, and 40 shillings to her old servant Margarett David.

Nominates & appoints her daughter Anne Meredith to be sole executrix and residuary legatee of her last will and testament.
