Abstract of the Will of John Morgan of Dol-bebin in the Parish of Llanbedr in the County of Merioneth, Yeoman, written 19 Feb 1810, proved 20 Sep 1810, probate granted 22 Nov 1810.

Gives, devises and bequeaths £5 to John Davies, son of John Davies of Cae'r athin in the Parish of Llanfair.

Gives, devises and bequeaths £5 to the children of Robert Jones of Penyrallt in the Parish of Llanbedr (viz. John, Margaret and Solomon), to be equally divided among them.

Gives, devises and bequeaths £500 to **his wife Catherine Lewis *alias* Morgan**, together with a moiety or one half of all his household furniture (except the bureau cupboard).

If Catherine Lewis *alias* Morgan chooses to live in a different house to that of her son (Morgan Jones *alias* Morgan) then she shall her choice of the milk cows and also her choice of one of the horses in addition to the aforesaid £500 and moiety of household furniture.

The other moiety of his household furniture together with the bureau cupboard and the rest, residue and remainder of his personal estate he gives, devises and bequeaths to **his son Morgan Jones *alias* Morgan**, whom he also nominates, constitutes and appoints sole Executor of his last will and testament.
