*Abstract of the Will of Robert Morris of Caeglas in the Parish of Trawsfynydd in the County of Merioneth, Farmer, written 16 Apr 1881, proved 10 Oct 1892.*

Gives and bequeaths 2s. 6d. to **his eldest son Morris Roberts**.

Gives and bequeaths 2s. 6d. to **his son Robert Roberts**.

Gives and bequeaths to **his daughter Margaret Jones** a feather bed and the clothes on it.

Everything else in his possession, freehold property, farming stock, implements of husbandry and household furniture he gives to **his wife Elizabeth Roberts**, to **his son Richard Roberts** and to **his daughter Elizabeth Roberts** share and share alike, and after the death of his wife her share will go to his son Richard and to his daughter Elizabeth.
