Item. Gives & bequeaths £5 to his brother Garth? Prys.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £5 to his brother-in-law Robert John.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to **his nephew Ellis Jones** a gun & pair of buffekin? breeches

Item. Gives & bequeaths £1 to his sister Elizabeth Prys.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 10 shillings to his nephew John Lloyd.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £1 to his niece Anne Lloyd.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 10 shillings to **Jane Lloyd**.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 10 shillings to his niece Catherine Prys.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 10 shillings to his niece Elizabeth Prys.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to his abovenamed granddaughter Catherine Robert a wainscoat chest in the room above his bedchamber.
