Gives and bequeaths £31 to **his son John Roberts** as well as an additional £9 to discharge a debt which he contracted in London if it isn't paid before his death.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to **his daughter Roberts of Blaen y ddol** to buy her a ring.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to his daughter Catherine to buy her a ring.

Gives and bequeaths 20 shillings to his daughter Anne Roberts to buy her a ring.

Gives and bequeaths £60 to his daughter Mary Roberts.

Gives and bequeaths half a guinea each to his grandchildren David Lloyd and Jane Lewis.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate he gives and bequeaths to **his** daughter Jane Roberts whom he makes the sole Executrix of his last will and testament.

Nominates and appoints his said son Griffith Roberts, his son-in-law Griffith Price of Corsgarnedd, his cousin John Lloyd of Brin Hîr, and his cousin Robert Roberts of Bryn Ysgyboria as Overseers of his last will and testament.
