Abstract of the Will of Mary Thomas of Llwyngeril Llangelynin, spinster, written 7 Jun 1725, proved 1731.

Gives, devises & bequeaths to **her niece Gwen Price** her heirs and assigns one moiety of a tenement of lands called Rywgaeron in Llyngoril in the parish of Llangelynin with appurtenances, as appears in an indenture dated 23 Feb 1702/3, with reversion and remainder to **her nephew Thomas Price**. And if Gwen should die while still a minor then the said moiety etc. will pass to [Gwen's brother] Hugh Price.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to her nephew Hugh Price six ewes.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to her nephew Hugh Thomas of Hendre half a guinea

Item. Gives & bequeaths 1 shilling to her cousin Ellin Thomas.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 30 shillings to the poor of Llangelynin.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £5 to her sister Anne Thomas.

Appoints her niece Gwen Price sole Executrix of her last will and testament.

Appoints Mr. Pierce White parson of Llangelynin as overseer of her last will and testament.
