Abstract of the Will of Mary Thomas of Llwyngeril Llangelynin, spinster, written 7 Jun 1725, proved 1731.

Gives, devises & bequeaths to **her niece Gwen Price** her heirs and assigns one moiety of a tenement of lands called Rywgaeron in Llyngoril in the parish of Llangelynin with appurtenances, as appears in an indenture dated 23 Feb 1702/3, with reversion and remainder to **her nephew Thomas Price**. And if Gwen should die while still a minor then the said moiety etc. will pass to [Gwen's brother] Hugh Price.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to **her nephew Hugh Price** six ewes.

Item. Gives & bequeaths to **her nephew Hugh Thomas of Hendre** half a guinea

Item. Gives & bequeaths 1 shilling to **her cousin Ellin Thomas**.

Item. Gives & bequeaths 30 shillings to the poor of Llangelynin.

Item. Gives & bequeaths £5 to **her sister Anne Thomas**.

Appoints her niece Gwen Price sole Executrix of her last will and testament.

Appoints Mr. Pierce White parson of Llangelynin as overseer of her last will and testament.
