Abstract of the Will of William Williams of Cessel Gwm Mawr in the Parish of Llanelltyd in the County of Merioneth, Yeoman, written 19 Jun 1772, proved 1 Sep 1779.

Gives and bequeaths £150 to **his daughter Elizabeth Williams**.

Gives and bequeaths £100 to **his son Evan Williams** towards his education, clothing and maintenance until he reaches the age of eighteen years.

Gives and bequeaths £100 to **his son Ellis Williams** towards his education, clothing and maintenance until he reaches the age of eighteen years.

Nominates and appoints **his wife Margaret John** guardian of the said children Evan and Ellis Williams until they arrive at the age of eighteen years.

Gives and bequeaths £250 to his wife Margaret John.

All the rest and residue of his personal estate, goods & chattels he gives and bequeaths to **his son John Williams** and his wife Margaret John, to be equally divided between them.

Nominates and appoints his son John Williams and his wife Margaret John joint executor and executrix of his last will and testament.
