Devises to friends and 'Aliesmen' John Poole of Dolgelly, apothecary, and Maurice Owen of Machynnlleth, gent., his messuages, lands and tenements called Penrhos Ucha, Penrhos bach, and Pant y Glo, etc. in t. Iscoed Penegoes, parish Penegoes, in tenures of Edward Pugh, (blank) and testator, to uses (declared) for 200 years reserving £7 rentcharge to wife Jane for life, then to son Griffith Tydder, to daughter Anne Tydder, then to wife Jane and heirs.

To raise £100 for daughter Anne Tydder at age 21.

Personal estate devised to wife Jane (sole executrix).
